His life

- Rafael Nadal was born in Manacor, Balearic Islands, Spain, to Sebastián Nadal .
- His mother is Ana María Parera, a housewife. He has a younger sister named María Isabel.

His life

- At the age of eight, Nadal won an under-12 regional tennis championship at a time when he was also a promising football player.
- This made Toni Nadal intensify training, and at that time he encouraged Nadal to play left-handed for a natural advantage on the tennis court .

His life

- When Nadal was 12, he won the Spanish and European tennis titles in his age group and was playing tennis and football all the time .
- Nadal's father made him choose between football and tennis so that his school work would not deteriorate entirely. Nadal said: "I chose tennis. Football had to stop straight away."

Tennis career

- In April 2002, at 15 years and 10 months, the world No. 762 Nadal won his first ATP match, defeating Ramón Delgado, and became the ninth player in the Open Era to do so before the age of 16 .
- The following year, Nadal won two Challenger titles and finished the year in the top 50. At his Wimbledon debut in 2003, Nadal became the youngest man to reach the third round since Boris Becker in 1984.
