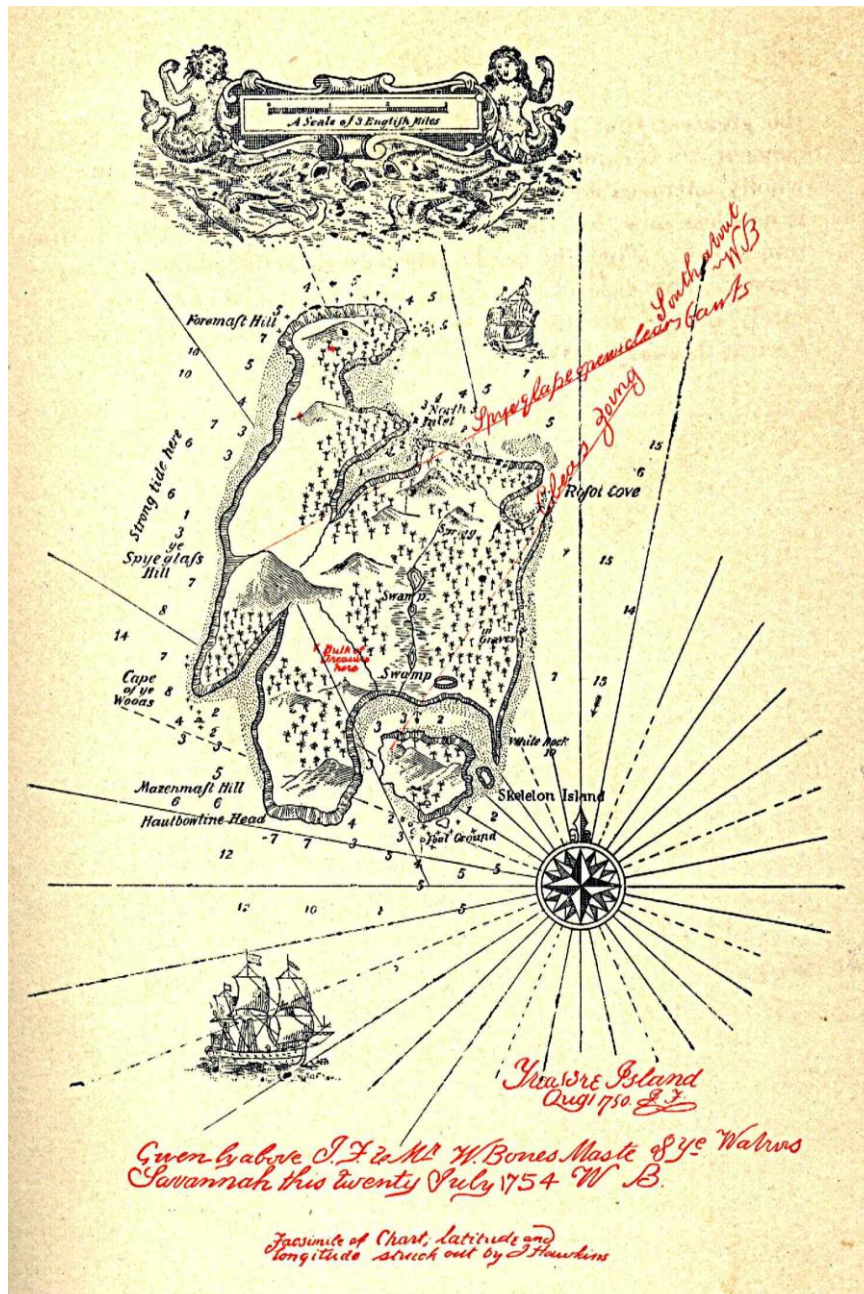


TREASURE ISLAND
