

EDUCATIONAL SYSTEM IN ENGLAND

It is known worldwide that England is the most organized country as far as education is concerned. More particularly, we know that Great Britain is divided into England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland. Furthermore, from the ages of 5 to 16 attendance at school is compulsory. Education is divided into primary, secondary and further education. Apart from that, the school system is made up from 12 subjects (English, Mathematics, Science, History, Geography, Music and more).
