Charlie Hebdo

- The magazine was founded in 1970
- The magazine is published every Wednesday
- The editor is Gerard Biard
- The magazine has been the target of two terrorist attacks, in 2011 and in 2015, presumed to be in response to a number of controversial Muhammad cartoons it published.

2006

- Controversy began over the publication's edition of 9 February 2006. Under the title "Muhammad overwhelmed by fundamentalists", the front page showed a cartoon of a weeping Muhammad saying "It's hard being loved by jerks".
- On 11 February 2006 Islamists marched against the publication of Muhammad.

2007

- What followed was what the French President, Jacques Chirac, said: "Anything that can hurt the convictions of someone else, in particular religious convictions, should be avoided". After a period of time the publisher Philippe Val contended "It is racist to imagine that they can't understand a joke".
- On 22 March 2007, executive editor Val was acquitted by the court.

2011 attack

- On 2 November 2011, the newspaper's office was firebombed and its website was hacked. Because of this, the magazine decided to change its name to "Charia Hebdo", with Muhammad listed as the "Chief-Editor".

2012

- In September 2012, Charlie Hebdo published six cartoons of Muhammad, one of which was called “Intouchables 2”, showing Muhammad in a wheelchair. The Muslims dragged the French magazine to court and demanded 580,000€. However, the newspaper's editor defended publication of the cartoons, saying, "We do caricatures of everyone and when we do it with the Prophet, it's called provocation."

2015 Attack

- On 7 January 2015, two Islamist gunmen barged in the main office of “Charlie Hebdo” and killed 12 people, 4 cartoonists, an economist, 2 editors, a guest and 2 police officers.
- President François Hollande described it as a "terrorist attack of the most extreme barbarity".

The survivors issue

- The day after the attack the magazine announced the publication of the next edition, which sold 5,000,000 copies.
