Plot

- As an orphaned child, Jane Eyre is first cruelly abused by her aunt, then cast out and sent to a charity school. Though she meets with further abuse, she receives an education, and eventually takes a job as a governess at the estate of Edward Rochester. Jane and Rochester begin to bond, but his dark moods trouble her. When Jane uncovers the terrible secret Rochester has been hiding, she flees and finds temporary refuge at the home of St. John Rivers.



About the Leading Actress

- Born in Edinburgh, Madeleine Worrall, 38, studied history of art at Cambridge, then drama at the London Academy of Music and Dramatic Art. She appeared in *Three Sisters* in the West End with Kristin Scott Thomas (2003) and played Cinderella in Stephen Fry's 2007 pantomime at the Old Vic. More recently, she devised and performed the title role in *The Strange Undoing of Prudencia Hart* and appeared in the film *Paddington*. Nowadays, Worrall is playing Jane Eyre in a stage adaptation of Charlotte Brontë's novel.
