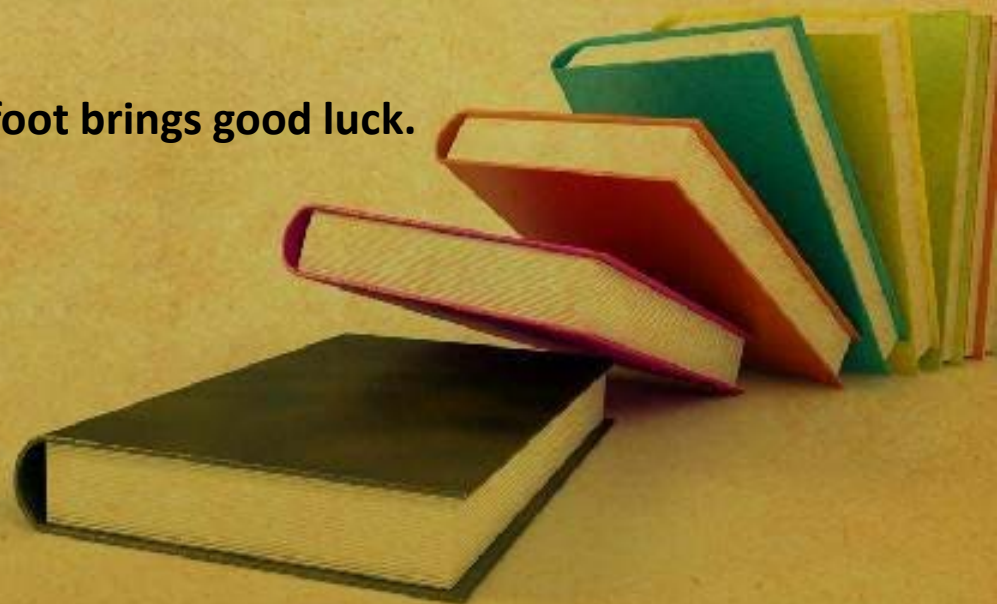
SUPERSTITIONS IN INDIA...

- Some Indian people are superstitious when they see a peacock before a trip. They say that it brings bad luck!
- Indian people believe in the 'evil eye', so, mothers put "Kol" on their babies' face, to ward it off.
- In some parts of India, sweeping the floor at night brings bad luck.



SUPERSTITIONS IN GREECE...

- Some Greek people believe that black cats bring bad luck.
- Greek people believe that when it is Tuesday or Friday the 13th of the month bad things will happen.
- If you break a mirror, you will have 7 years of bad luck. People also believe that if you look at the mirror after midnight, great evil will find you.
- Greek people also believe in the 'evil eye'.
- Greek people also believe that the rabbit foot brings good luck.



SUPERSTITIONS IN EGYPT...

- The most famous superstition in Egypt is that evil people can throw a spell on someone. It can cause illness or other misfortune.
- Egyptians believe that owls bring bad news to people.
- If an Egyptian woman wants to make a very tasty meal, she should throw some salt over her shoulder before cooking.
- It is bad luck if you leave open scissors.



SUPERSTITIONS IN AUSTRALIA...

- Australian people believe that walking under a ladder brings bad luck.
- People believe that when you spill salt, you will have very bad luck.
- Australian people believe that when you have a horse shoe with you, you will have really good luck.
