**AUSTRIA!**



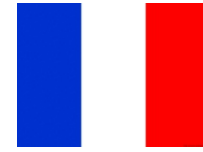
**BELGIUM!**

# FRANCE!

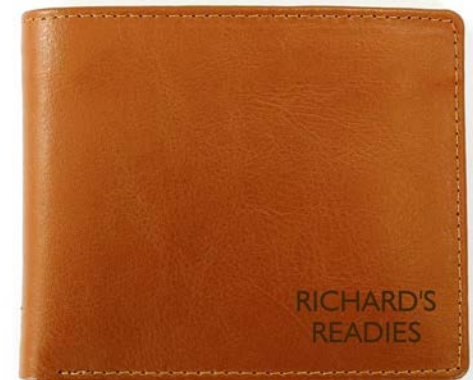


Never give to a French a knife as a gift, because this means that you want to “cut” your friendship with them.

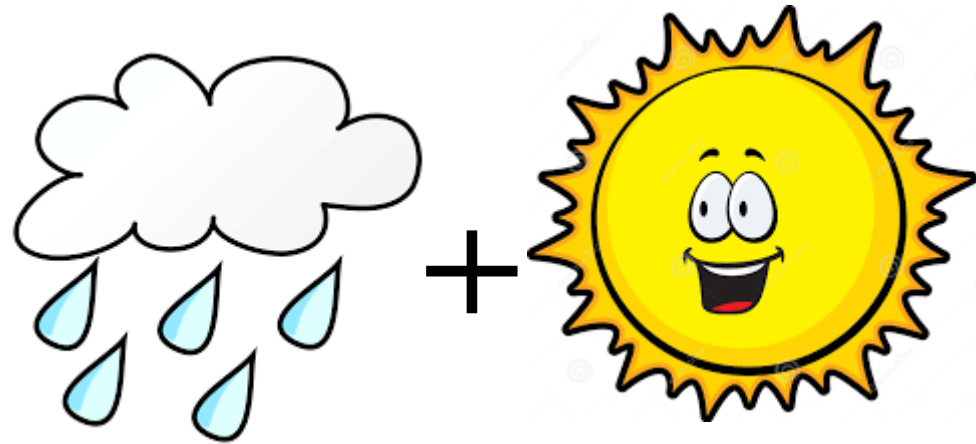
**SWEDEN!**
