


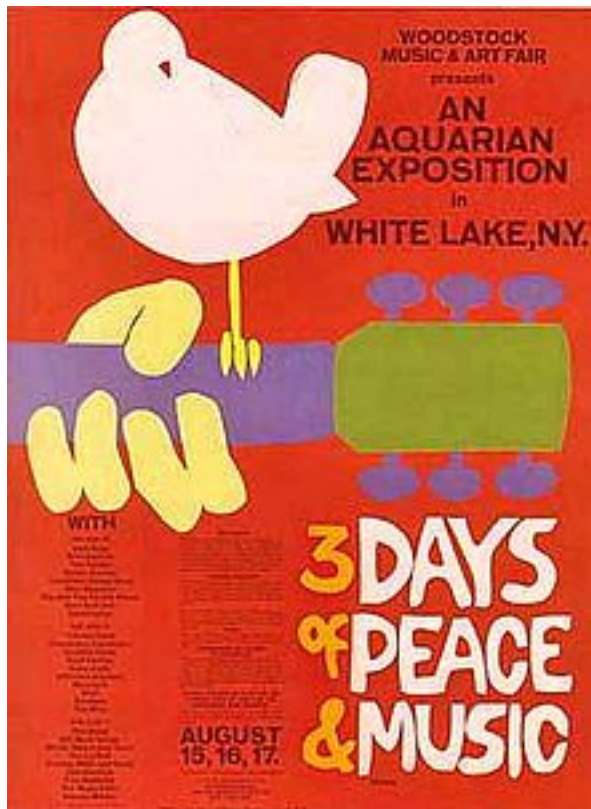
# HIPPIE MOVEMENT!!!
