- North Vietnam was supported by the USSR, China and North Korea.
- South Vietnam was supported by the United States, Thailand, New Zealand and the Philippines.
- It was a conflict between communist and capitalist (part of Cold War).
- US tried to prevent a communist takeover of South Vietnam.
- Finally, military involvement ended 15/8/1973.
- North and South Vietnam reunified in 1976.
- A lot of soldiers and civilians were killed (about 3,1 million)
