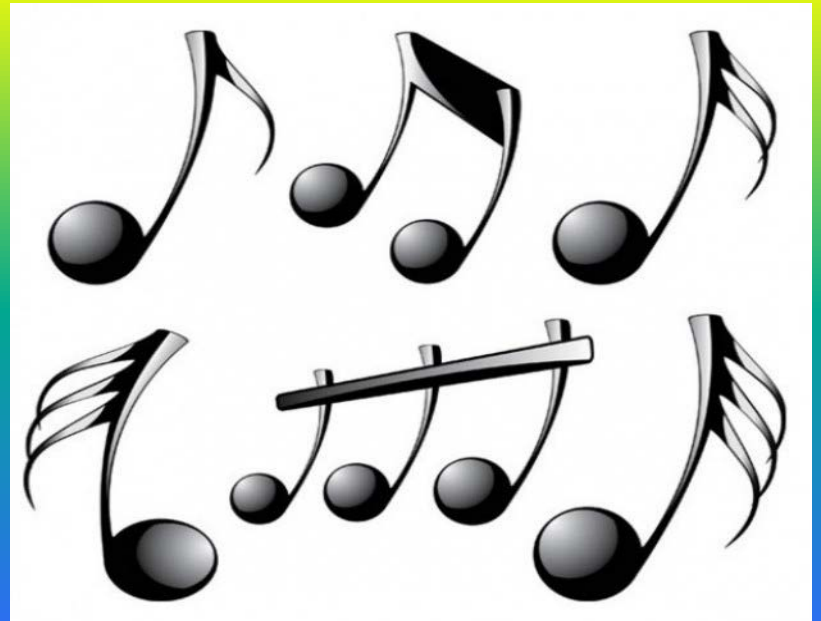

■ In 1966, she joined the band *BIG BROTHER and the HOLDING COMPANY*.

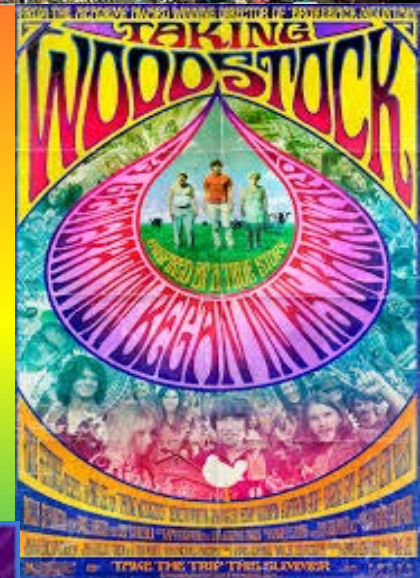
■ In 1968, their album "*Cheap Thrills*" was a huge hit.

■ At Woodstock Festival (August 1969), in a historic performance, Joplin released her first solo effort with the song "*I GOT DEM OI*" *Kozmic Blues Again Māmá!*

■ Joplin remains one of the top-selling musicians in United States.
