HIS BIOGRAPHY

- Martin Luther King Jr. was a social activist, who led the Civil Rights Movement in the United States from the mid-1950s until his death .
- He was killed in 1968 because he was against slavery .
- He was born on January 15, 1929, in Atlanta, Georgia .

- King received the Nobel Peace Prize in 1964.
- He continues to be remembered as one of the most important African-American leaders in history .
- People often talk about his 1963 speech, "I Have a Dream."

- “I am happy to join with you today in what will go down in history as the greatest demonstration for freedom in the history of our nation.” By Martin Luther King
- His dream was to have peace in the American society. To have equality between all people no matter what you looked like, what your skin color or what your nationality.

- ◉ The African-American Civil Rights Movement was a fight for racial equality that took place for over 100 years after the Civil War. Martin Luther King and others believed in peaceful protests against slavery.
