WHO IS SHERLOCK HOLMES?

He is the man who put the "detect" in detective, practised forensic science and made the occupation of private detective a very cool thing.

Sherlock Holmes started his career in London in the early 1880s. We don't know much about him before then, but he was connected with Scotland Yard. He became famous in the whole world, thanks to the pen of Dr. John H. Watson and the literary marketing genius of Sir Arthur Conan Doyle.



SHERLOCK HOLMES



Sherlock Holmes is a private detective created by British author Sir Arthur Conan Doyle. Holmes is famous for an excellence in observation, forensic science, and logical reasoning. He investigated cases for a wide variety of clients, including Scotland Yard. He first appeared in print in 1887. He became famous all over the world with the first series of short stories in *The Strand Magazine*, beginning with *A Scandal in Bohemia* in 1891; additional stories appeared from then to 1927. He appeared in four novels and 56 short stories. Almost all are set in the Victorian or Edwardian periods, taking place between 1880 to 1914. Dr. Watson, the character of Holmes's friend and biographer narrates the stories and usually accompanies Holmes during his investigations. Many of the stories begin in 221B Baker Street, London.

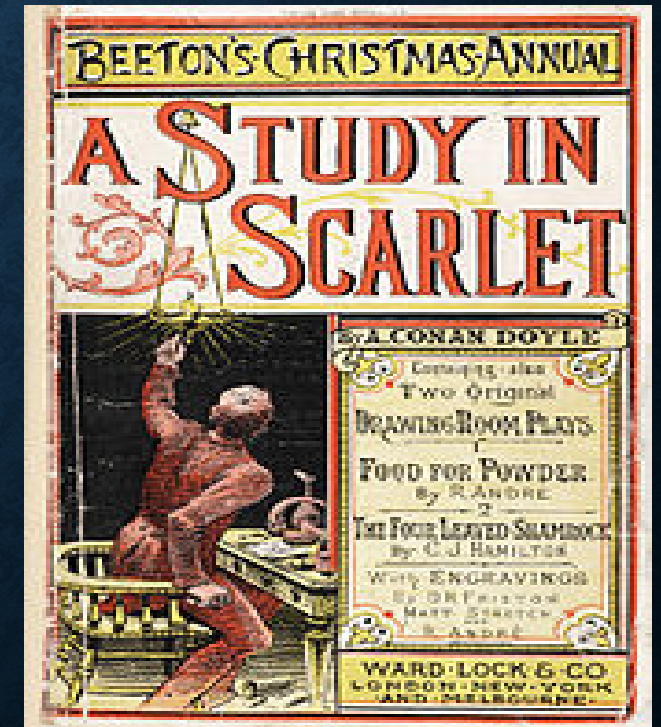
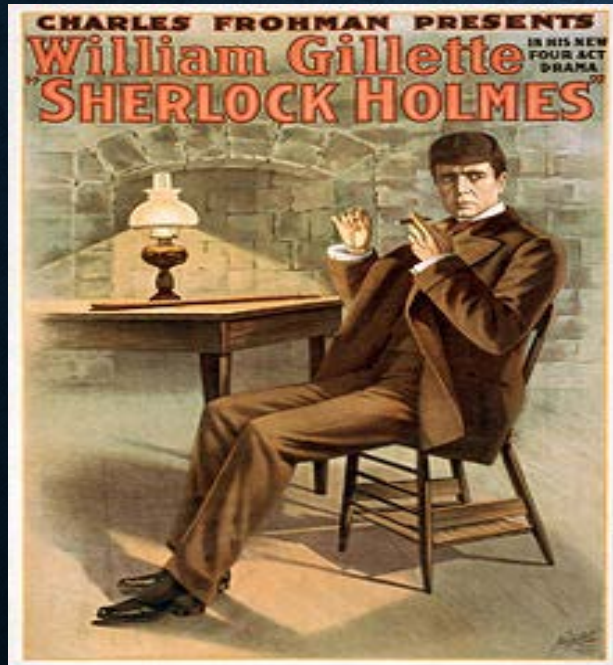
THE HOUSE OF SHERLOCK HOLMES

Sherlock Holmes lived at 221b Baker Street between 1881-1904, according to the stories written by Sir Arthur Conan Doyle. He lived with his loyal friend and colleague Dr. Watson. The house is protected by the government due to its "special architectural and historical interest" and the 1st floor study overlooks Baker Street. It is kept as it was in Victorian Times.



THE STORIES OF SHERLOCK HOLMES

Sherlock Holmes appeared in a total of 60 stories, written by Arthur Conan Doyle. The four novels and five volumes of short stories now often appear as *The Complete Sherlock Holmes*.

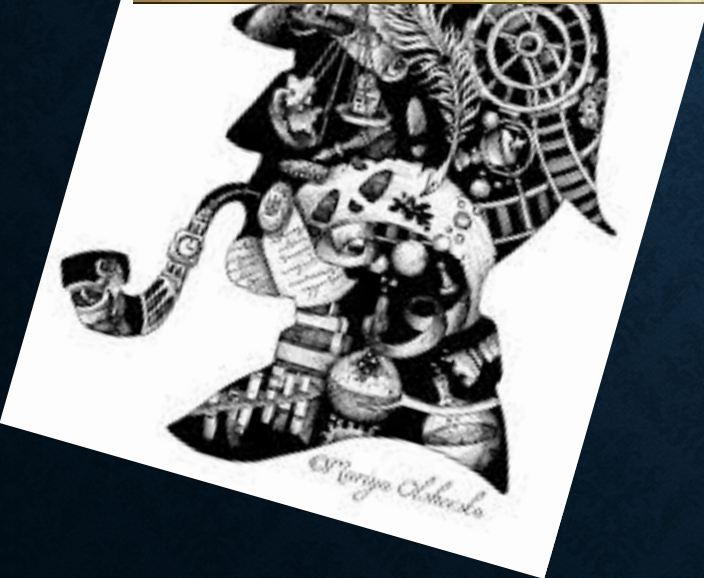
