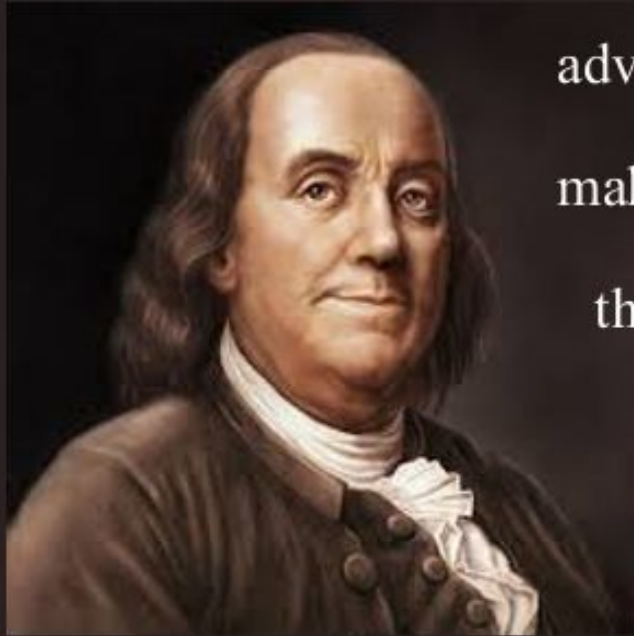
# What is modern slavery?

- Slavery did not end with the Abolition in the 19th century.
- The practice still continues today in one form or another in every country in the world. From women forced into prostitution, children and adults forced to work in agriculture, domestic work, or factories and sweatshops producing goods for global supply chains to entire families forced to work for nothing, to pay off generational debts, or girls forced to marry older men, the illegal practice is still on in the contemporary world.
- According to the International Labour Organisation (ILO) around 21 million men, women and children around the world are in a form of slavery.

# Child Slavery

- Despite the fact that many people believe that slavery no longer exists, the International Labour Organization (ILO) estimated that there are some 8.4 million children in slavery or practices similar to slavery.
- This is child slavery, as defined by the 1956 UN Supplementary Slavery Convention. In these cases, as well as being in a hazardous situation, there is an intention to exploit these children for someone else's gain.

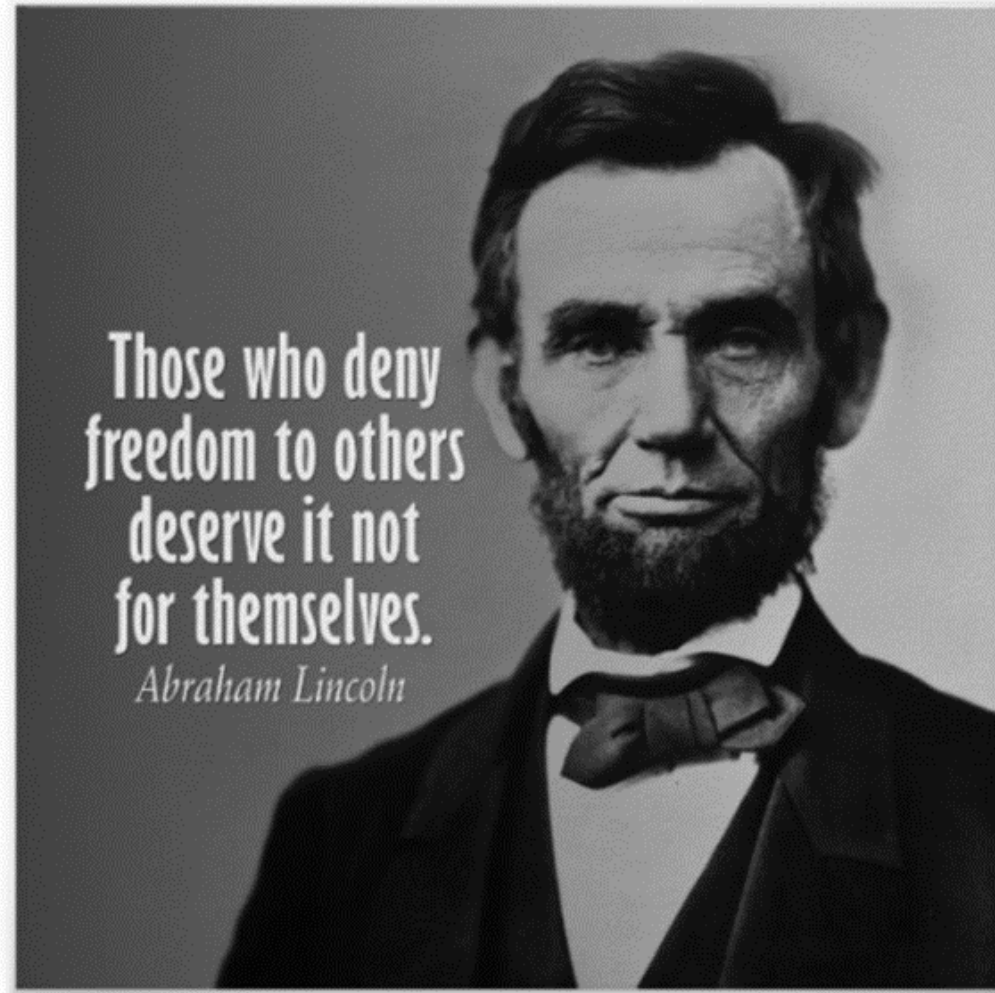
