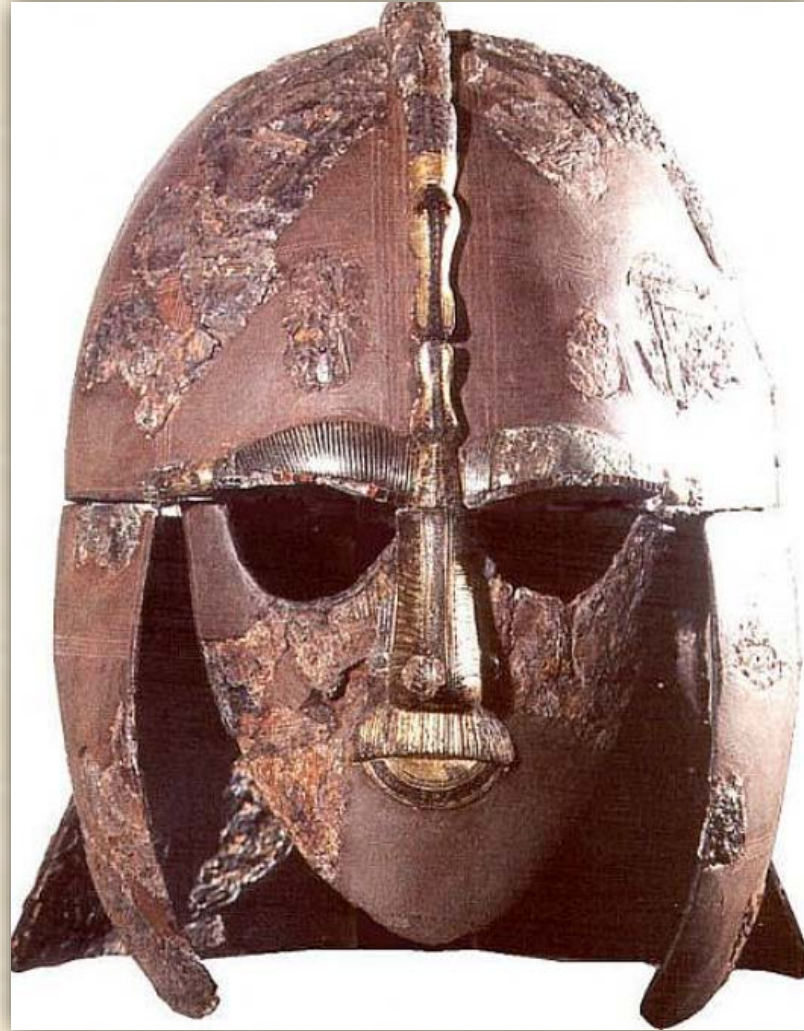

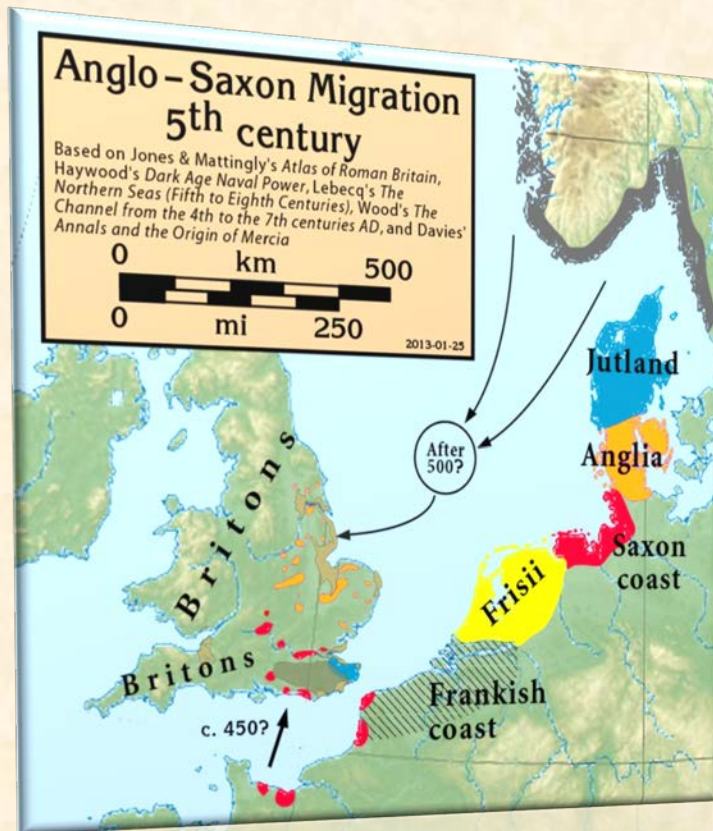

The Anglo-Saxons were members of Germanic-speaking groups. They migrated to the southern half of England from continental Europe. Anglo-Saxon history begins following the end of the Roman times. They created Anglo-Saxon kingdoms in the 5th and 6th centuries and they became Christians during the 7th century. They faced the Viking invasions during the 9th and 10th centuries, and ended their rule with the Norman conquest of England by William the Conqueror in 1066. Anglo-Saxon identity survived in the following centuries, and came to be known as English developing into the modern times.
