

The 10 biggest Irish rivers

River Foyle and river Erne

- River Foyle passes from Tyrone, Londonderry and Donegal and its length is 129km. River Erne passes Cavan, Fermanagh and Donegal its length is 129km.



River Liffey and Suck

- River Liffey passes from Wicklow, Kildare, Dublin and its length is 132 km. River Suck passes from Roscommon, Galway and its length is 133km.



Rive Nore and Bann

- River Nore passes from Tipperary, Laois, Kilkenny and its length is 140 km. River Bann passes from Down, Armagh, Antrim, Londonderryes and its length is 159km.



River Blackwater and River Suir

- River Blackwater passes from Kerry, Cork, Waterford and its length is 168km. River Suir passes from Tipperary, Waterford, Kilkenny, Wexford and its length is 184km.



The two biggest rivers Barrow and Shannon

- River Barrow passes from Laois, Kildare, Kilkenny, Carlow, Wexford, Waterford and its length is 192km. The biggest one is Shannon and it passes from Cavan, Leitrim, Roscommon, Longford, Westmeath, Galway, Offaly, Tipperary, Clare, Limerick, Kerry and its length is 360km.
