Birmingham, the largest and most populous British city outside London, is famous for its six universities, that make it the largest centre of higher education in the country outside London.

Some things about the environment: In Birmingham, there are 571 parks (more than any other European city) , including Birmingham Botanical Gardens, located close to the city centre.



Economy: Birmingham grew as a manufacturing and engineering centre, but its economy today is dominated by the service sector. Birmingham is the largest centre in Great Britain for employment in public administration, education and health. After Leeds, Birmingham is the second largest centre outside London for employment in financial and other business services.



Transport: Birmingham is a major transport hub on the motorway, rail and canal networks. Birmingham New Street is the busiest railway station in the United Kingdom outside London.
