

The Parthenon



- The Parthenon is a temple in Athens. It is dedicated to the Goddess Athena. The construction started in 447 BC and was completed in 432 BC.

It has a classical architectural style.
It is 13.72m height. The architects
of Parthenon were Iktinos and Kallikrates
and the designer was Phidias.

From 1800 to 1803, Thomas Brunce removed some of the surviving sculptures with the permission of the Ottoman Empire. The sculptures are now in the British Museum in London.
