

Pavlopetri

The city of Pavlopetri is an ancient city in Lakonia in Peloponnesse. It was possibly erected about 5.000 years ago. The name came from the Christian saints Pavlos and Pertos. This city was discovered in 1967 by Nickolas Flemming. Today in this area the island Elafonissos is located. The city had buldings almost 3 to 4 metres in height. The excavations showed that in the city lived people from 2.8000 B.C. The archeologists believe that Pavlopetri was probably communicating with Crete.
