



The Greek educational system is divided into three levels, both compulsory and optional. Starting with Nursery schools that concern ages 1 to 5 years old, the children have the chance to familiarize with their first school environment where they can naturally socialize and spend their time creatively.

Secondly, Primary school is the next educational step of compulsory attendance that lasts six years. During these school years, children come in contact with reading and writing skills.

Primary Education takes 6 years and secondary education takes 6 years, the last three of which are optional. Upper Secondary Schools are divided into the Technical Vocational Schools and the Unified Upper Secondary ones.

In Greece, there are both public and private schools.
