



Secondary education is divided into two sections: gymnasio (which is compulsory) and lykeio (which is not compulsory). Gymnasio is the first level of secondary education and it is compulsory for children aged 12 to 15. It lasts three years. The school year generally runs from mid-September to mid-May, with classes five days a week. The school week is 34 to 35 hours.

Pupils are assessed orally and with written tests and projects. Written examinations are planned for the end of each term. A leaving certificate allows pupils to continue their studies by enrolling at a lykeio or enter a vocational training programme at the Technical-Vocational Educational Institutes (TEE).
