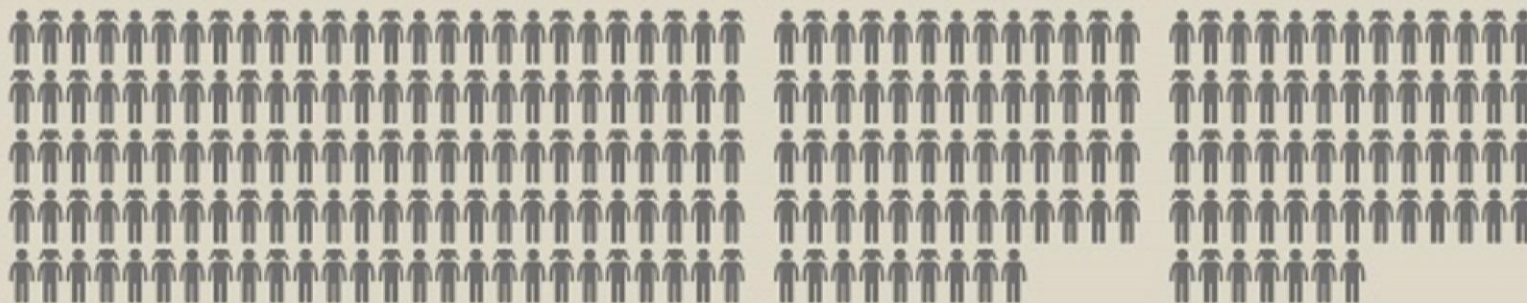


**"EDUCATION IS NOT A PRIVILEGE.

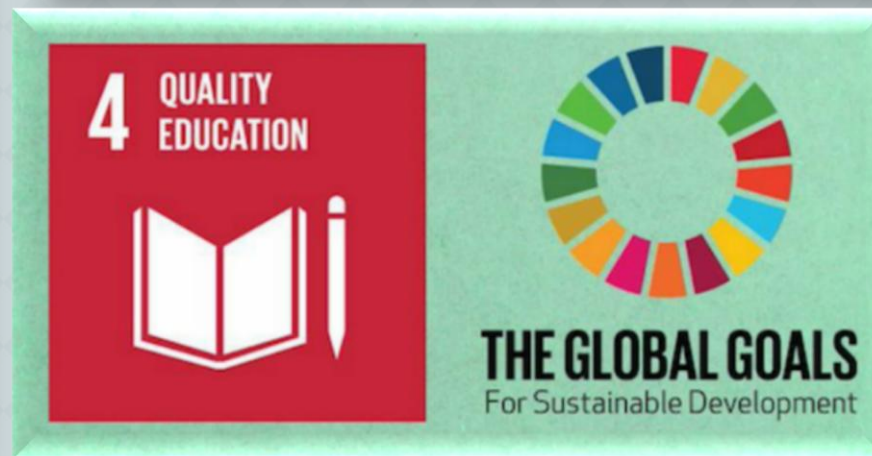


Save the Children®

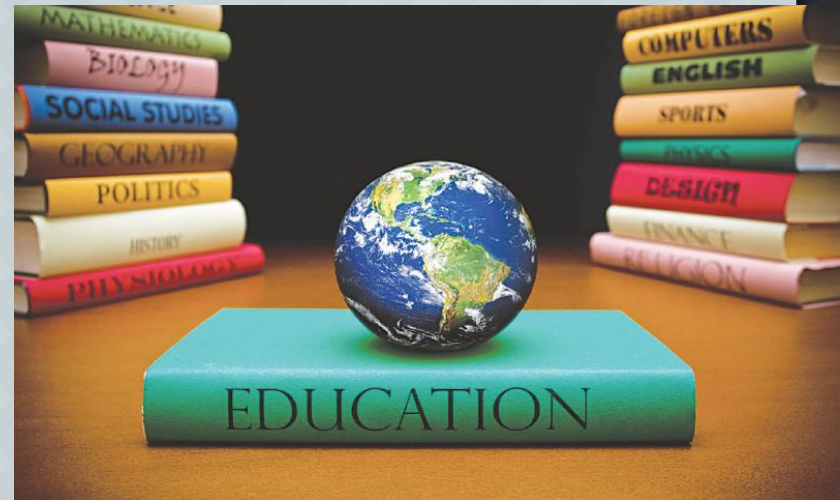
It is the organisation's firm belief that aside from life-saving basic necessities like food, water and shelter, children caught up in conflict need protection - physical and emotional - and education so that they don't become a lost generation. An integrated response to their needs should be provided as well as immediate humanitarian relief, long-term solutions and continued campaigning for an end to conflicts.



Recognising Sustainable Development Goal 4 which commits the world to "ensure inclusive and equitable quality education and promote lifelong learning opportunities for all", *Save the Children* has launched a global campaign entitled 'Every last child'. This campaign is committed to tackling the barriers that stop some children from learning and surviving.



Deeply concerned by the fact that millions of children are excluded from progress due to a toxic mix of poverty and discrimination, through its global campaign and ongoing work on the ground with communities and its project “securing a future for all children”, *Save the Children* is focused on reaching the world's most marginalised and deprived children, ensuring their survival and protection.

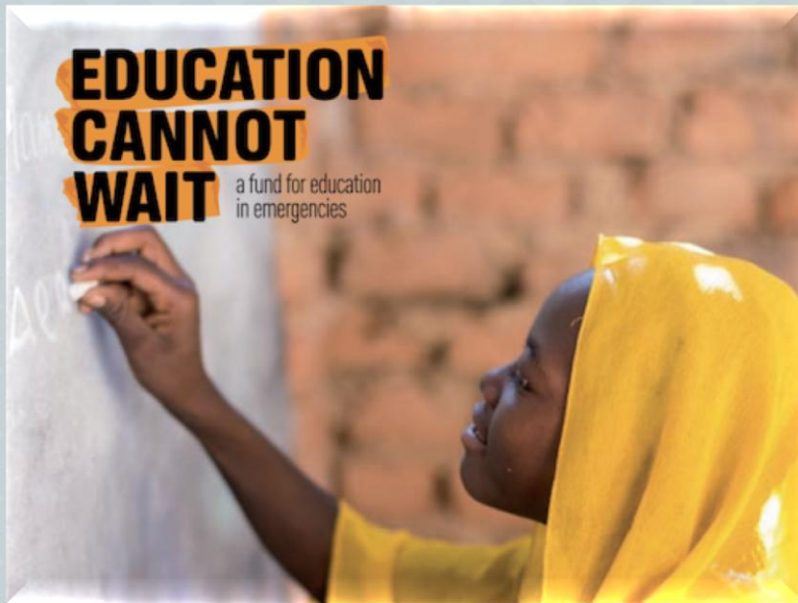

Domestic financing: It calls on developing countries to increase their tax bases, distribute revenues progressively, and prioritise education in national budgets. It calls on OECD (Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development) countries and multinational companies to promote corporate transparency to curb illicit financial flows.



Multilateral aid: It calls on donors to channel a minimum of 30% of education aid through multilateral channels, to fully fund the Global Partnership for Education and the Education Cannot Wait fund for education in emergencies, and on the multilateral development banks to establish an International Financing Facility for Education.



Save the Children provides tools that empower entire communities to better support their children's health, education, protection and growth - breaking the cycle of poverty for generations to come.



Each of us can contribute by becoming a sponsor. That means that for on more than a \$1 a day we ensure a brighter future for a child. Moreover, as a sponsor, we provide encouragement and hope for our sponsored child through messages and birthday cards.

Additionally, *Save the Children's* corporate partners come from industries of all shapes and sizes and all of them are vital to building programmes for children.



In 2015, 183,000 sponsors supported programmes that directly benefited more than 2.8 million children in 23 countries around the world. Thanks to the growing community of child sponsors, *Save the children* increased its impact and reach - helping 29% more children than in 2014.
